BALAAM AND HIS DONKEY (NUMBERS 22-24:25)



The Bible says that the children of Israel were a mighty nation. As they wandered through the wilderness, they fought many battles. God always helped them win. The King of Moab was afraid of the Israelites. His name was Balak.

King Balak believed that a man named Balaam, was a prophet. He thought that if Balaam would say bad things about the Israelites, King Balak would be able to defeat them. So, He sent men to ask Balaam to curse God's people. They even offered him money.



Balaam really wanted the money. But God told Balaam not to take the money from King Balak. He did not want Balaam to ever say bad things about the Israelites. So, Balaam did not take the money and he did not go with the king's men.
