




GOD RAISES UP JUDGES - EHUD JUDGES 2 & 3



The Bible says that after Joshua died, the Israelites started worshipping the false gods of the Canaanites.


God sent an angel of the Lord to warn them. The angel brought a message from God, "I told you to break down the altars to the false gods. You have disobeyed Me. I will no longer help you drive out the Canaanites."





God's warnings came true. God let an enemy king take over the Israelites. When the Israelites went into battle they were defeated. Their enemies constantly carried out raids to steal their crops and belongings.

Then the Israelites remembered how good they had it when they loved and obeyed God. They cried out to Him, "Save us!" So, the Lord raised up judges. The judges taught them to obey God. Judges helped fight to save the Israelites from their enemies.





Othniel was the first judge. He fought against the enemies. He helped the Israelites turn back to God. The land was peaceful for 40 years, then Othniel died.

Again, Israel forgot about God. God gave the king of Moab power to attack the Israelites and defeat them. The Israelites remembered how good they had it when they loved and obeyed God. They cried out to Him, "Save us!" So God raised up Ehud to save them.






The Israelites sent Ehud to the king of Moab. Ehud said, "I have a secret message for you." The king dismissed all his attendants so he was alone with Ehud. Ehud was left handed, so he had his sword hidden under his cloak on his right side. The king's quards didn't notice it.

When the king stood up, Ehud pulled out his sword. He pushed it into the king's fat belly. Ehud escaped and locked the doors behind him. The king's servants came in and found their king dead!



When Ehud escaped, he blew a ram's horn and he became the Israelites' leader. There was peace in the land for 80 years.
