BIRTH OF JOHN THE BAPTIST (Luke 1)



The Bible says that Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth were old. But they had no children, and that made them sad. Zechariah was a priest who helped in God's temple.



One day a very special thing happened to him. He was chosen to be the one priest to go inside the temple and burn incense while the people stood outside and prayed. Zechariah must have felt especially happy as he entered the temple.



Suddenly an angel appeared in front of him! The angel said, "Don't be afraid, Zechariah. God has heard your prayer. Your wife Elizabeth will have a son. You will name him John. He will help people follow God's chosen leader.

Zechariah still could not talk. So, he asked for a writing tablet and on it wrote, "His name is John."


