JESUS AT THE TEMPLE AT AGE 12 (Luke 2:40-52)



The Bible says, "Jesus grew in wisdom, stature, and in favor with God and man." Jesus grew up in the town of Nazareth doing the things that boys do. He played games with his friends and he went to school. His father Joseph was a carpenter. Jesus helped make things.

Every year the Jews traveled to Jerusalem for the Passover Feast. It took many days to get to Jerusalem. Jesus' family traveled with lots of other families to be safe. Jesus probably enjoyed walking with his friends and cousins. He might have played games and talked with them as they walked.


Jesus grew and he obeyed his parents in everything they said. He made his mother and Joseph very happy. Mary treasured all these things in her heart.


Luke 2:52 says that Jesus grew:

We should all try to be like Jesus!


