

## SERMON ON MOUNT (PART 5) TREASURES, DON'T WORRY & A HOUSE ON THE ROCK (MATT 6:19-34; 7:13-27)



The Bible says that when Jesus was teaching his Sermon on the Mount he talked about **treasure**. Sometimes people think too much about getting <u>earthly</u> treasures. But nothing in this world lasts forever.

Things can break or get lost or even stolen. Jesus said, "Do not lay up treasures upon earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up treasures in heaven." <u>Treasures in heaven last forever</u>! Which treasures do you love the most? Jesus said, "Where your treasure is, there will your heart be also."





Jesus said, "No one can serve two masters... You can't serve God and money." Jesus wasn't just talking about money. He was talking about loving things of this world – like trophies or toys, or even loving to play too much. Nothing should be more important to us than loving and serving God.

Jesus also said, "**Don't worry!**" Look at the birds in the sky. They don't worry. God feeds them. Aren't you more valuable than the birds? Don't worry - God will give us what we need.


But the one who doesn't live by my words is like the foolish man who built his house on the sand. The rain and floods came... and the house on the sand fell.






