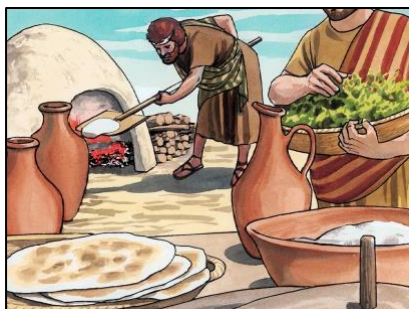
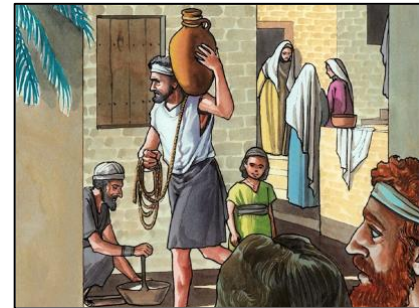


## THE LAST SUPPER (JOHN 13:1-30)



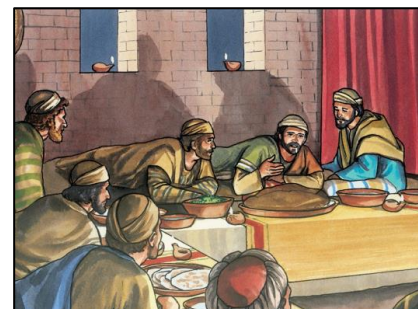
The Bible says that Jesus and his apostles went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. This special meal helped Jews to remember how God freed them from slavery in Egypt. God told the Jews to eat the Passover Meal every year.

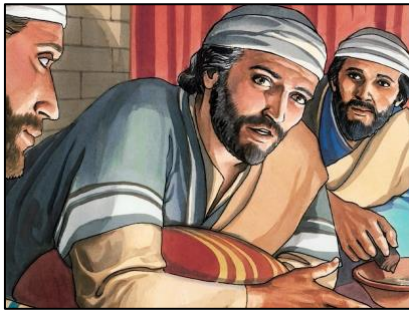
It was time for Jesus and his apostles to eat the special meal. So, Jesus told Peter and John to go into Jerusalem and get things ready. He told them to follow a man carrying a water jar. That man would take them to the house where they would eat the Passover Meal in an upstairs room.



Peter and John did exactly as Jesus said. They cooked the lamb and unleavened bread. They got the bitter herbs and wine ready too.

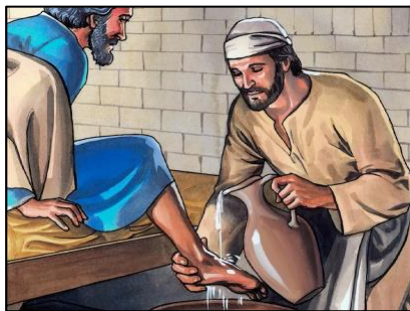
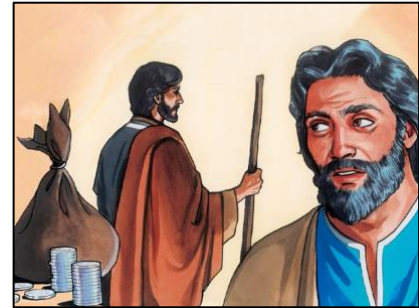
Jesus and his apostles ate the Passover Meal together. They remembered the lamb's blood that was put on the doorposts. They drank grape wine and ate unleavened bread. They remembered that God had saved them.





Jesus explained that this would be the last Passover supper he would eat with them. He said that soon the supper would have a new meaning. Jesus said the bread will remind them of Jesus' body that he is going to sacrifice. The wine will remind them of Jesus' blood. **We call it the Lord's Supper.**

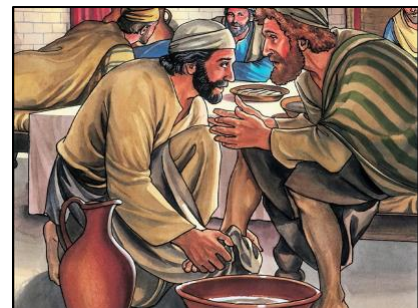
Then Jesus said, "One of you is not really my friend. He will betray me and give me over to people who will hurt me." Judas knew that he was the one. Some of the Jewish leaders had already given him money to make sure Jesus got arrested.



Then Jesus did something that surprised them all. He wrapped a towel around his waist. He poured water into a bowl and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel.

Peter didn't want the Lord Jesus to wash his dirty feet. But Jesus explained that he would wash, not only the dirty feet, but all of Peter. Jesus even washes hearts to make them clean.
