JESUS IS ALIVE AGAIN! (MATTHEW 28, MARK 16, LUKE 24, and JOHN 20)

The Bible says that before Jesus was crucified, he told his followers that he was going to die. But he also said he would be raised on the third day.



After Jesus died, two friends came to get his body. They were Joseph (from Arimathea) and Nicodemus. They wrapped Jesus' body with long strips of cloth. They put the body into a tomb that had been carved out of a rock. Pilate put soldiers to guard the tomb.

Remember how Jesus said he would be raised on the third day? He died and was buried on Friday (the first day). Saturday was the second day. Before sunrise on Sunday (the third day) something amazing happened! There was a violent earthquake and an angel of the Lord came from heaven. The angel went to the tomb, rolled away the stone and then sat on it. The frightened guards fainted.





Some women went to the tomb. When they arrived, they saw that the stone had already been moved by the angel! The angel told them the good news, "He is risen!" Mary Magdalene cried because she thought someone had stolen Jesus' body. She looked inside the tomb. There she saw two angels. "Why are you crying?" they asked.

When Mary turned around she saw another man. She thought it was a gardener. "Have you taken Jesus' body?" Then the man said, "Mary." It was not the gardener, it was Jesus! Jesus really was raised from the dead on the third day just as he had said!

Then Jesus appeared to two men who were walking along a road. When they ate together they realized it was Jesus. He was raised from the dead!


Jesus showed them where the nails had been and where the soldier had stuck a spear into his side.




