understanding.

⁸ Believe in the value of wisdom, and it will
make you great.

Use it, and it will bring honor to you.

⁹ Like... a crown, it will make you look
beautiful.”

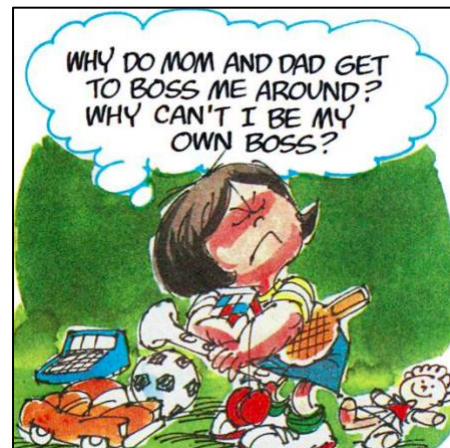
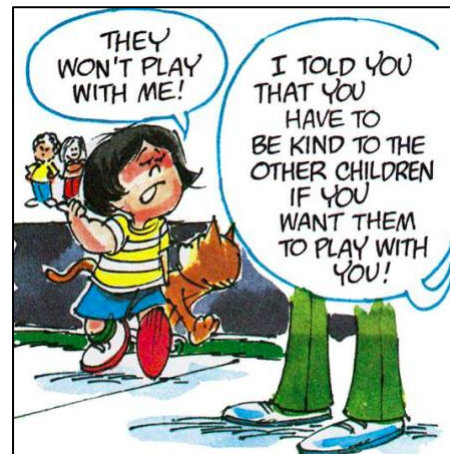
