GET WISDOM! Lesson 7:

BE WISE! DON'T HANG WITH THE BAD GUYS. (Proverbs 12:26 & 20; 13:20, 21; 4:14-17; 22:24,25)

Proverbs 12:26 "The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray." (*NIV*)

Proverbs 13:20 "Whoever spends time with wise people will become wise. But whoever makes friends with fools will suffer." (*ICB*)



We want to be kind and friendly to everyone. We want to include everyone when we play a game, etc. But, we must understand that we learn things from our friends. They influence us. They can teach us to bad things, or they can teach us to do good things. So, we must be careful when we choose who we will hang out with, who will be our close friends. We should ask ourself, "**Will this friend help me, or pull me down?**"

Here is a good example from Proverbs 22:24, 25:


"Don't make friends with someone who easily gets angry.


Zacchaeus the Tax Collector Hung Out With the Wrong Guys! (Luke 19:1-10)

But when Zacchaeus became friends with Jesus, he changed. This new friendship had a good influence on Zacchaeus.






Zacchaeus completely changed for good! He became a new man and repaid all the people that he had cheated.
