GET WISDOM! - Lesson 16: BE WISE! USE GOD'S HOUSEPLANS TO BUILD YOUR HOME. (Proverbs 24:3,4; 10:25; 3:9-12; 28:27; 5:18, 31:10-31; 22:6)



(Proverbs 24:3) "By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established." (ESV)

Do you think Solomon is talking about the physical house you live in? Or, is he talking about your home and family? Read the translation below:

"It takes wisdom to have a good family. It takes understanding to make it strong." (NIV)

Here is another Proverb from Solomon: "When the whirlwind passes, the wicked is no more, But the righteous *has* an everlasting foundation." (Proverbs 10:25) (NASB)

Do these proverbs remind you of Jesus' teaching about building your house on the rock foundation of God's Word? Solomon is teaching us the same thing! What kind of family do *YOU* want to have when you grow up? Do you want a family built on the wisdom of God or a family built on a worldly foundation? Decide NOW that you will use God's house plans to build your own home.

"The Lord disciplines those he loves, just as a father [disciplines] the child that he delights in. (*Proverbs 3:12*)


• Love your children. Show them God's way.
