Proverbs 4:23 "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it."

For our bodies to be physically healthy, we know we need a good strong heart. Our physical heart pumps blood all around our body and keeps us healthy. The Bible says that we need a good strong spiritual heart. Our spiritual heart is so important that we much guard or protect it, above all else!



What is the heart the Bible talks about?

The spiritual heart is ... ME! It's like a room inside me where I have my thoughts and desires. My heart is all the things that I love and treasure. The Proverb says that everything I do comes from my heart. My heart is where I decide what I will do and why I want to do it.

Why is it important to guard our heart?

We need to keep bad things out. If I let anger stay in my heart, out will come fighting and arguing with my family and friends. If I let pride stay in my heart, out will come bragging. If I let selfishness stay in my heart, out will come unkindness toward my friends.





On the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus said,

"A good person has good things saved up in his heart. And so he brings good things out of his heart. But an evil person has evil things saved up in his heart. So, he brings out bad things. A person speaks the things that are in his heart." (Luke 6:45)

How do we guard our heart?


