Lesson 16: PAUL IS ARRESTED, TRIED AND IS SHIPWRECKED (ACTS 20:13-22:9, ACTS 24-16, ACTS 27-28)



The Bible says Paul's 3 trips had taken him to far away places. But now it was time to go to Jerusalem and talk about God to the people there.

In Jerusalem Paul went to worship at the Temple. Some of the angry Jewish leaders saw him. They drug him outside and beat him. They lied and called Paul a trouble maker. Paul was arrested by Roman soldiers. They were going to whip him. But Paul said, "I am a Roman citizen! You can't do this to me!"

always trust in God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit! They have a great plan!


