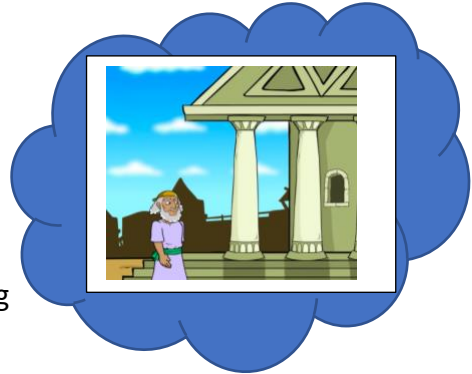


Lesson #5: GOD SENDS THE PROPHET ISAIAH TO HIS PEOPLE IN JUDAH (Isaiah 6)



The Bible says that the people of the kingdom of Judah were living in sin. They had forgotten all of the wonderful things God had done for them. They did not keep God's commandments and instead prayed to false gods. God wanted to choose a prophet messenger to tell the people to stop sinning and turn back to God.

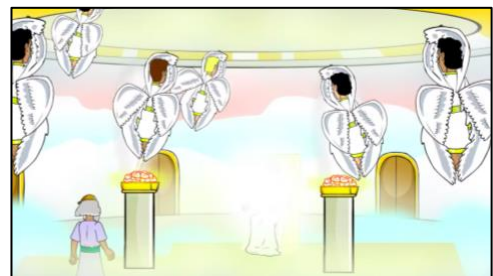
Isaiah lived in Judah. He loved God and was sad that the people were not obeying God. So, God sent Isaiah a dream. It is also called a vision. In his dream Isaiah was in the Temple.



In the vision Isaiah saw God sitting on His throne.



God's throne was surrounded by angels called Seraphs (or seraphim.) Each Seraph had 6 wings. 2 wings covered their faces, 2 wings covered their feet, & with 2 wings they flew.



The seraphim sang, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord God Almighty!" Their voices made the Temple shake.



When Isaiah saw this, he cried out, “Woe to me. I am an unclean. I have seen the King, the Almighty Lord!” Isaiah knew that he wasn’t perfect. He had sinned and the people of Judah had sinned.



Then with tongs, one of the Seraphs took a hot coal from the altar. He touched Isaiah’s lips with a glowing coal. The angel said, “Your sins are forgiven.”



God asked, “Who shall I send to the people of Judah with my message?” Isaiah replied, “Here I am, Lord! Send me!”

God told Isaiah it would be a hard job. “The people won’t listen, so I am going to punish them. But I am also sending a message of hope. I will not punish them forever.”

The next day Isaiah began to tell the people what God said. For 65 years Isaiah told the people the sad news. “You have sinned. God will punish you. Stop sinning and obey God!” His teachings are in our Bible book of Isaiah.

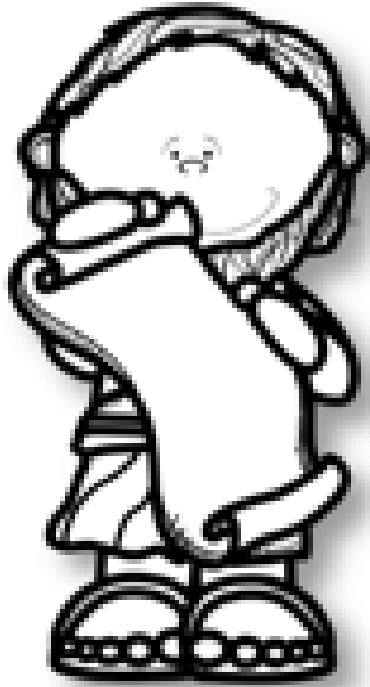


But no, the people didn’t return to God. Instead, they laughed and made fun of Isaiah. But Isaiah did not forget that God had a message of hope too. Isaiah told the people, “God will send a new king – a perfect king! His name will be Jesus. He will not be like the bad kings you have seen. He will be Mighty God, Prince of Peace, the Forever King! He will be from the family of David. He will bring goodness (righteousness) and justice.”

The people were so happy to hear that the Forever King is coming! God used Isaiah to tell the good news about Jesus. He wants to use you, too. Tell your friends and family about the Good Forever King Jesus!

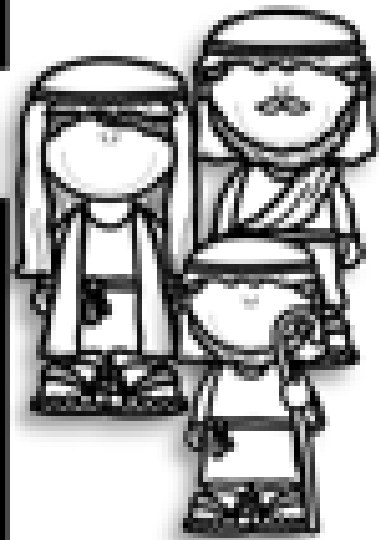
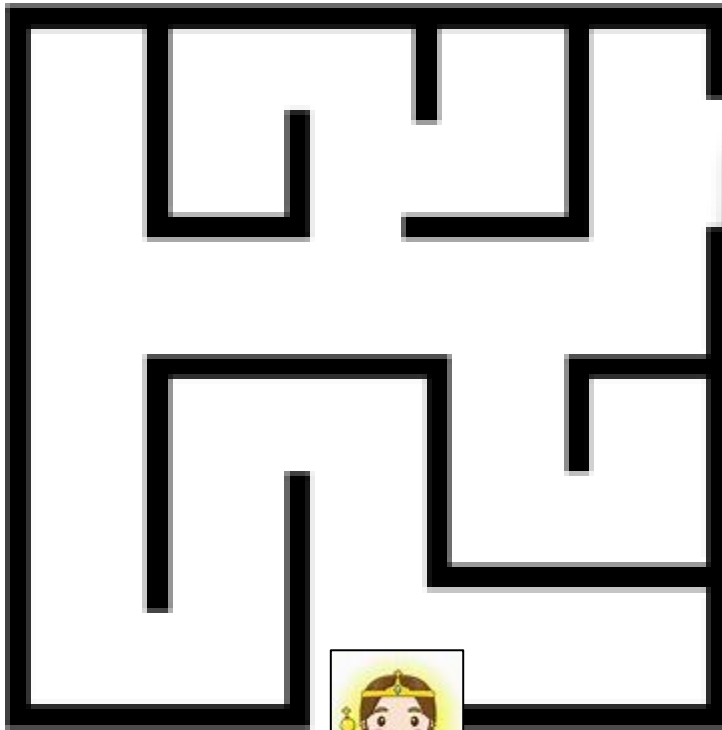
