The prophet Hosea said that Jesus and his family would have to run away to Egypt because some wanted to kill baby Jesus.

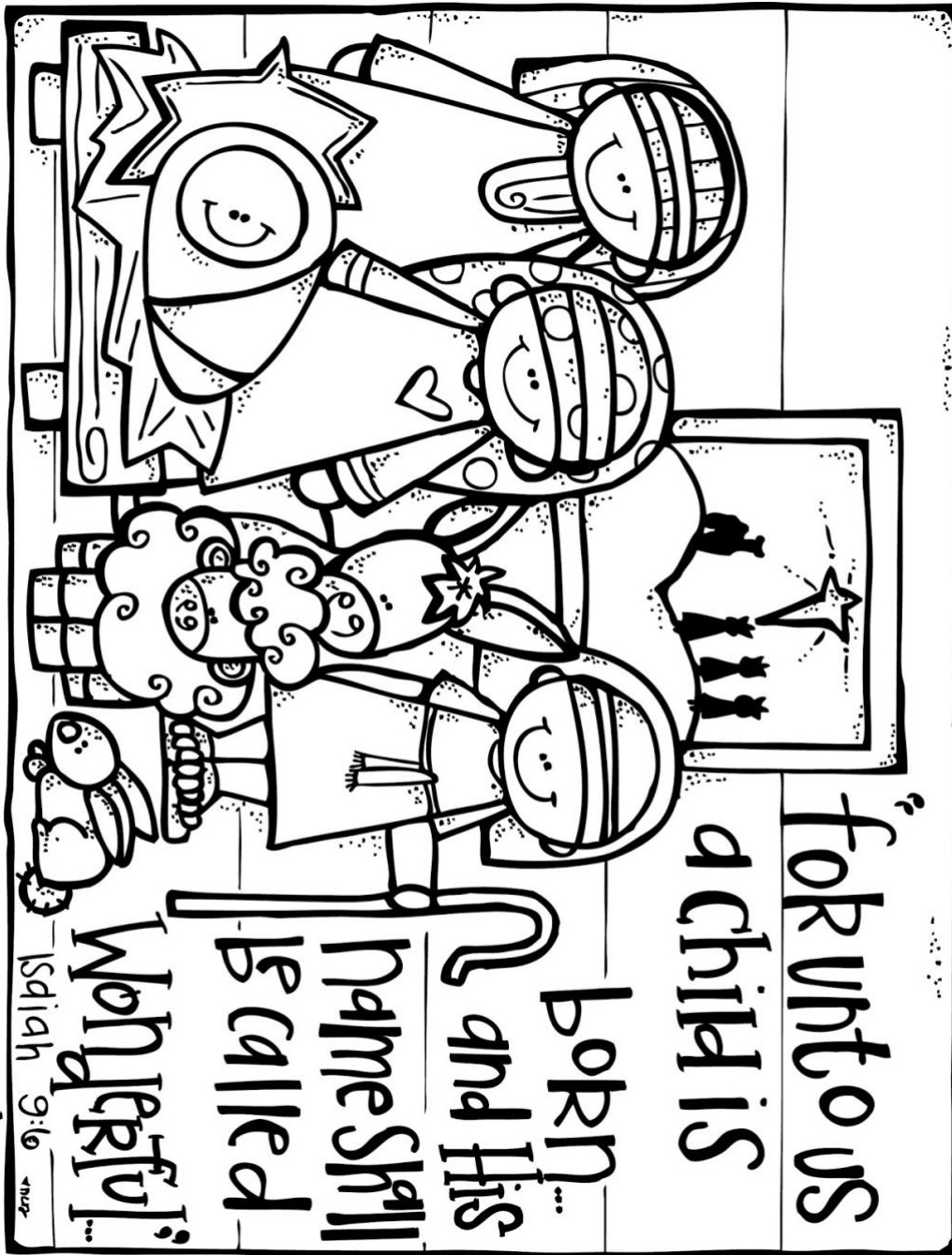


Isaiah even prophesied that Jesus would suffer And take the sins of the world. He would die so that anyone who believed and followed Jesus would be saved from sin.

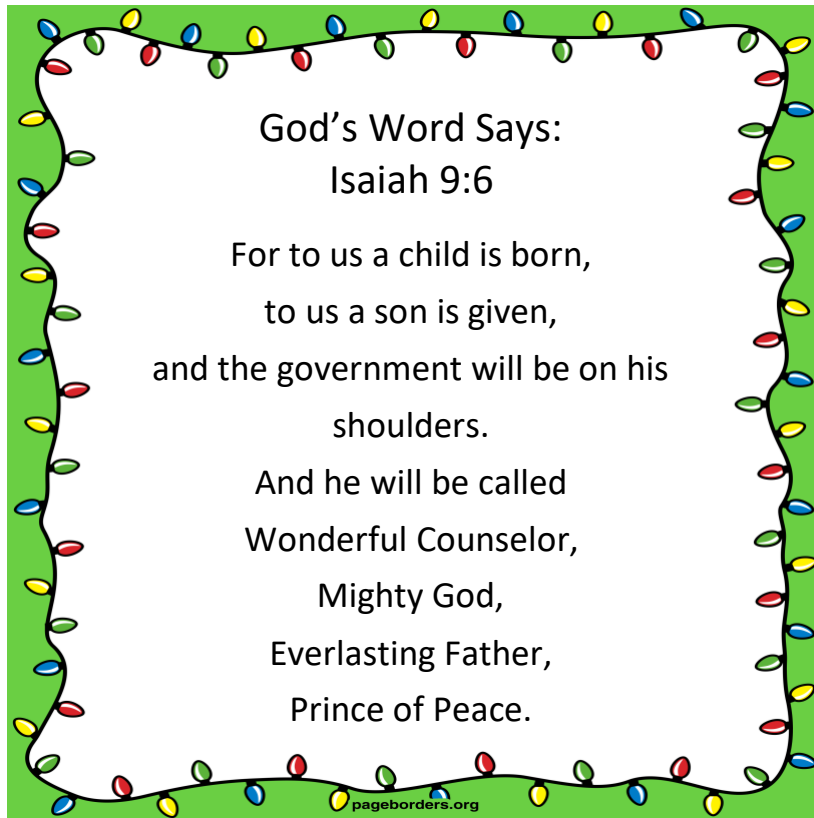
