



Lesson #13: SODOM & GOMORRAH (GENESIS 18:1-8 – 19:1-29)



The Bible says that Abraham was sitting in the shade outside his tent. He saw 3 strangers standing nearby. Abraham didn't know it, but they were angels. Abraham said, "Please stay awhile and rest under the trees near my tent. It's cool and shady here. I'll bring you water to wash your tired, dusty feet and give you something to eat and drink."

Abraham and Sarai made food for them. While they ate, the angels said they wanted to tell them some news. Next year Sarai will have a baby boy! Sarai was in the tent and when she heard that, she laughed to herself because she was old.





But the angels also brought bad news.
