Lesson #14: ISAAC IS BORN! (GENESIS 17:15-22, 18:1-15, 21:1-7)



The Bible says that the Lord appeared to Abraham. The Lord said, "I am God All-Powerful. Obey me and do what is right." God promised him that he would have as descendants as there are stars in the sky. He changed Abram's name to Abraham, which means "Father of many." God also said, "I will change the name of Sarai, your wife. Her new name will be Sarah. [The name Sarah means "Princess or Important Woman."] God said, "I will give her a son, and you will be the father."

Abraham bowed to the ground and laughed. He said to himself, "Can a man have a child when he is 100 years old? Can Sarah give birth to a child when she is 90?" Then Abraham said to God, "Please let Ishmael be the son you promised." Ishmael was about 13 now. He was the son of Abraham and Hagar.




