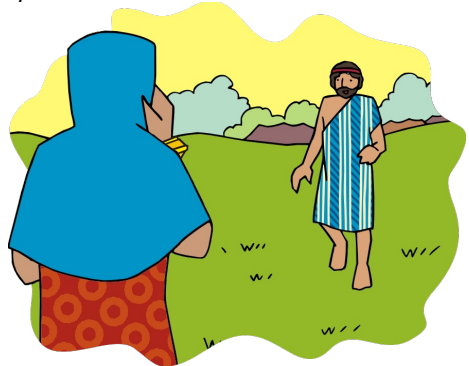

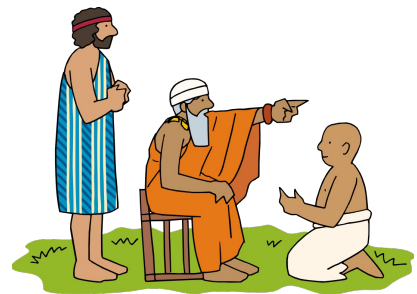


### Lesson #16: ISAAC MARRIES REBEKAH (GENESIS 24)

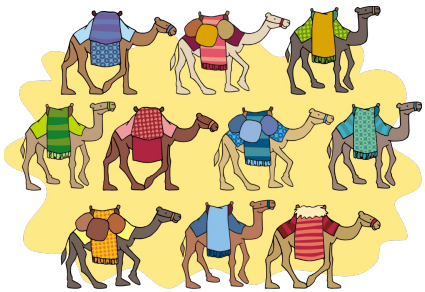

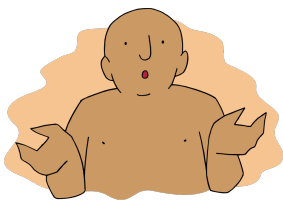
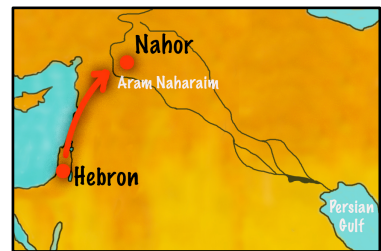


So, Abraham spoke to his servant, “Go to my home country, and find Isaac a wife there. God will help you.”

The servant told them how God had led him to Rebekah. Then he asked, "Will you let Rebekah go with me back to Canaan to marry Isaac?"



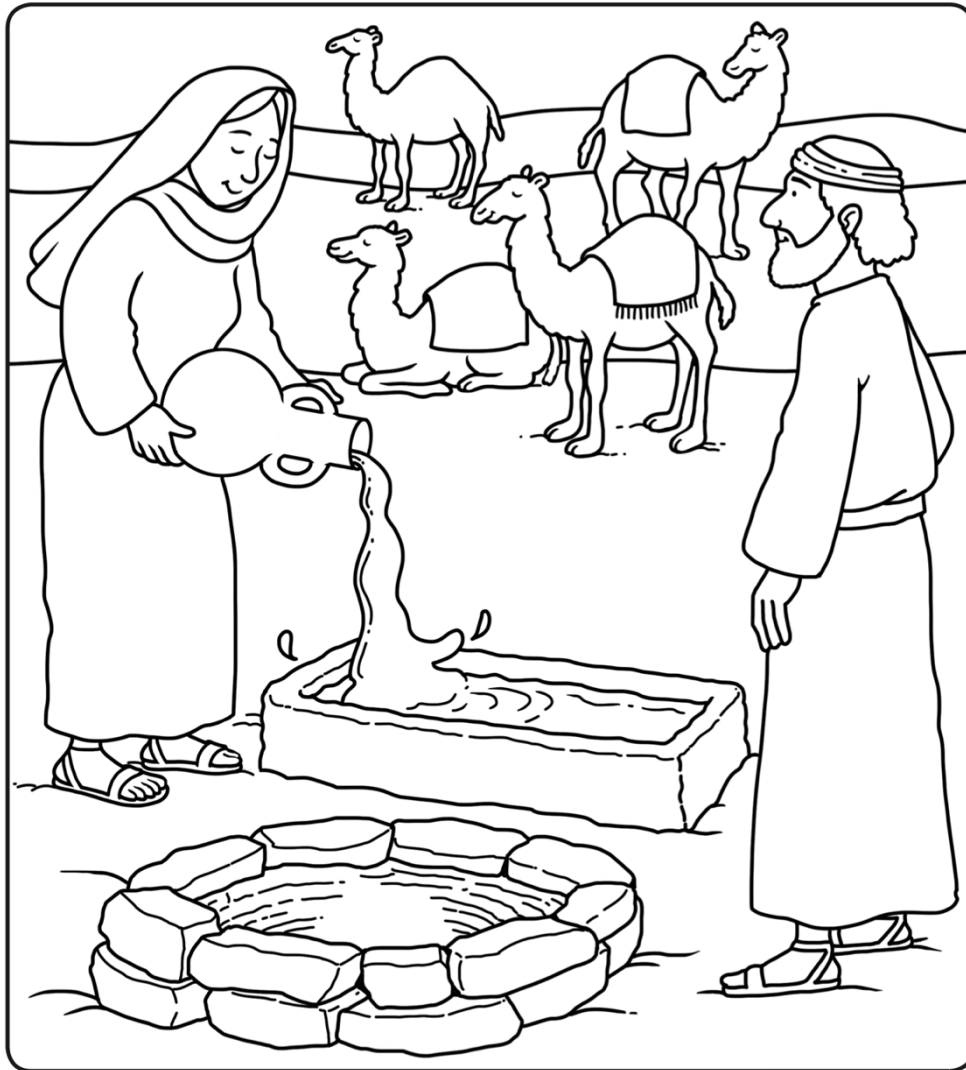
Her father was happy for Rebekah to be part of God's plan. He said "yes." Rebekah was happy too. So, she went with the servant on the long trip to Canaan.
