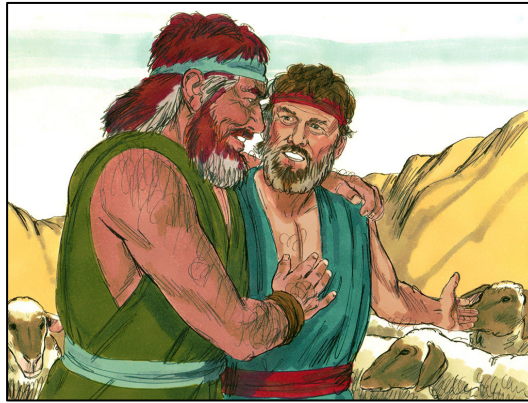
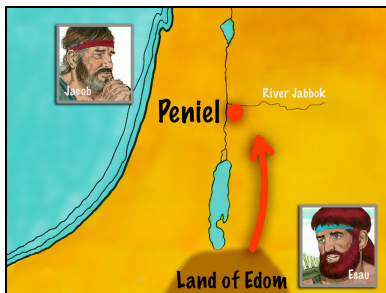

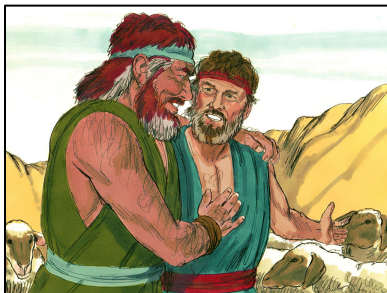


#6 JACOB & ESAU REUNITE GENESIS 33 & 35

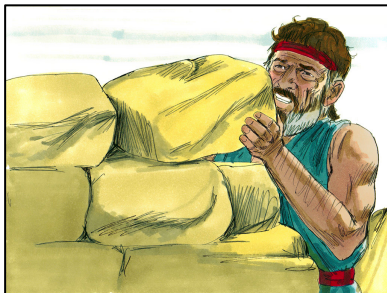
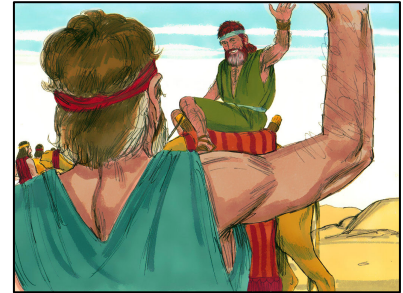

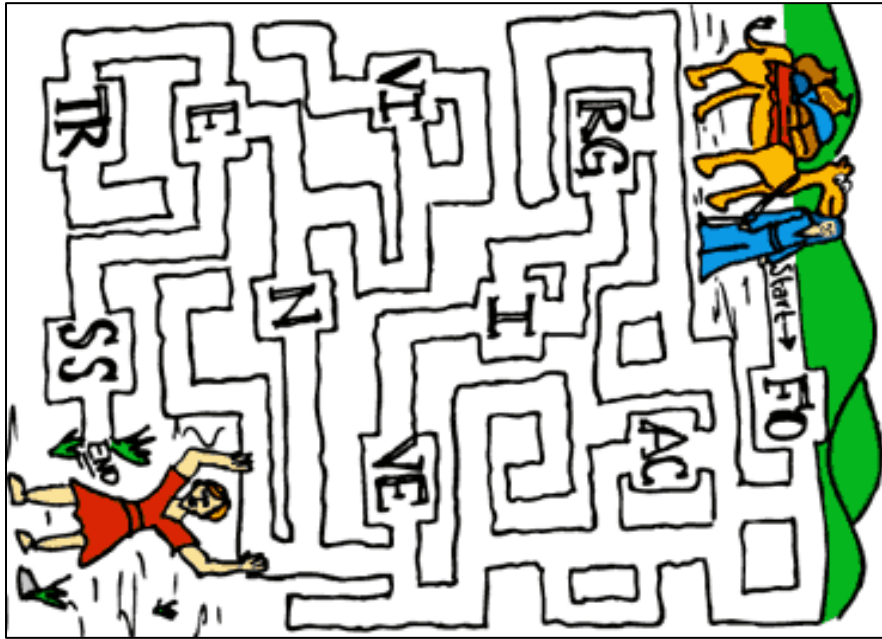
