

Lesson#12: JOSEPH RULES IN EGYPT (GENESIS 41:47-57)



The Bible says that Joseph rode in his chariot all around Egypt. He taught the farmers to plant food. For 7 years the land produced great crops with lots of food! There was plenty of food for everyone to eat. During those years, Joseph led tams if Egyptian workers to build granaries in each city. These were places to store the surplus (extra) grain.




Joseph gathered some of the grain from all the farms. There was so much grain that it was like sand on the seashore. Finally, there was too much grain to even measure. So, Joseph stopped counting and keeping records. With God's help, Joseph was being a good ruler in Egypt.

During this time, 2 sons were born to Joseph and his wife, Asenath. Joseph named his first son Manasseh (meaning "God has made me forget all my troubles.") He named his second son Ephraim, (meaning 'fruitful.') "God has made me fruitful in this land."



People from all around came to Egypt to buy grain from Joseph. People even came from other countries to buy food.


