Job knew that his wife and friends were wrong. He still loved God, but he didn't understand. He asked God, "Why are these things happening?"



God healed Job and gave him more animals and children. Satan's plan had not worked. Job lived to be 140 years old. The end of Job's life was even better than the beginning.


