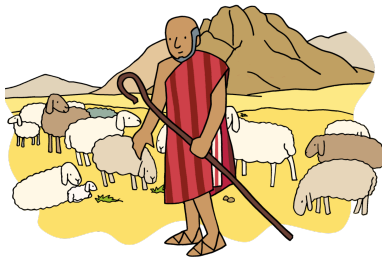

Lesson 3: MOSES & THE BURNING BUSH
(Exodus 3-4)



The Bible says that Moses was looking after the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro. He led the sheep to graze by a mountain called Horeb.

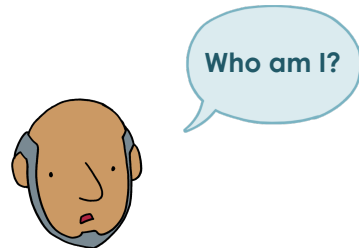
Moses saw a bush that was on fire. But the bush did not burn up! So, he decided to take a closer look. Suddenly Moses heard a voice coming from the burning bush, "Moses." It was God's voice! Moses answered, "Here I am."



God said, "Take off your shoes for you are standing on holy ground." God said, "I am the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." Moses was afraid to look at God, so he hid his face.

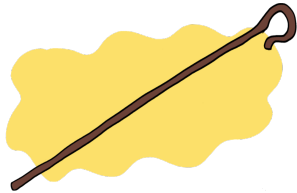
God said, "I have seen the suffering of my people. I am going to rescue them out of slavery. I will bring them to a land of milk and honey where they will be free."

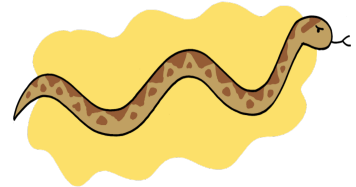

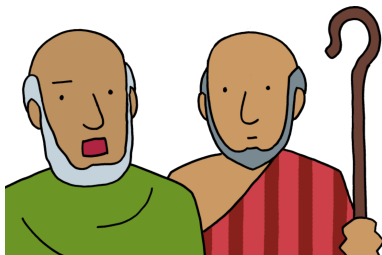
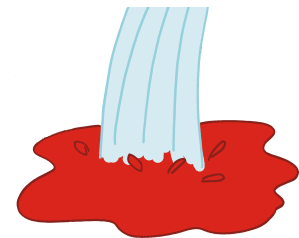
Moses was worried that the Hebrew leaders wouldn't believe that God really sent him. So, God gave Moses the power to do miracles.

Then God told Moses to put his hand inside his cloak. When he pulled it out it, his hand was covered with a disease called leprosy. When he put it in again, it was healed. God said, "If they still don't believe you, "Go to the Nile River and fill a jug with water. Pour it out and it will turn into blood.



Moses said, "I can't talk well. Please send someone else." God said, "Who made your mouth?" But then God said, "I will send your brother Aaron. He will talk for you." Moses and Aaron did just what God told them to do.

What do you **KNOW** about GOD from this lesson? **Do you think He will always help us?** When God tells us to do something, **will He give us whatever we need to do it?**

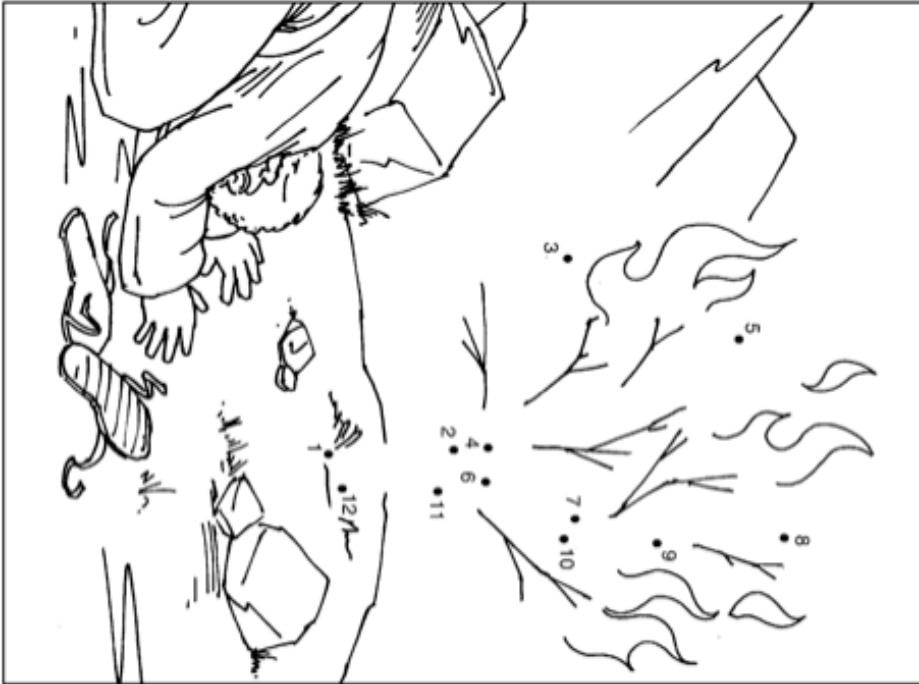

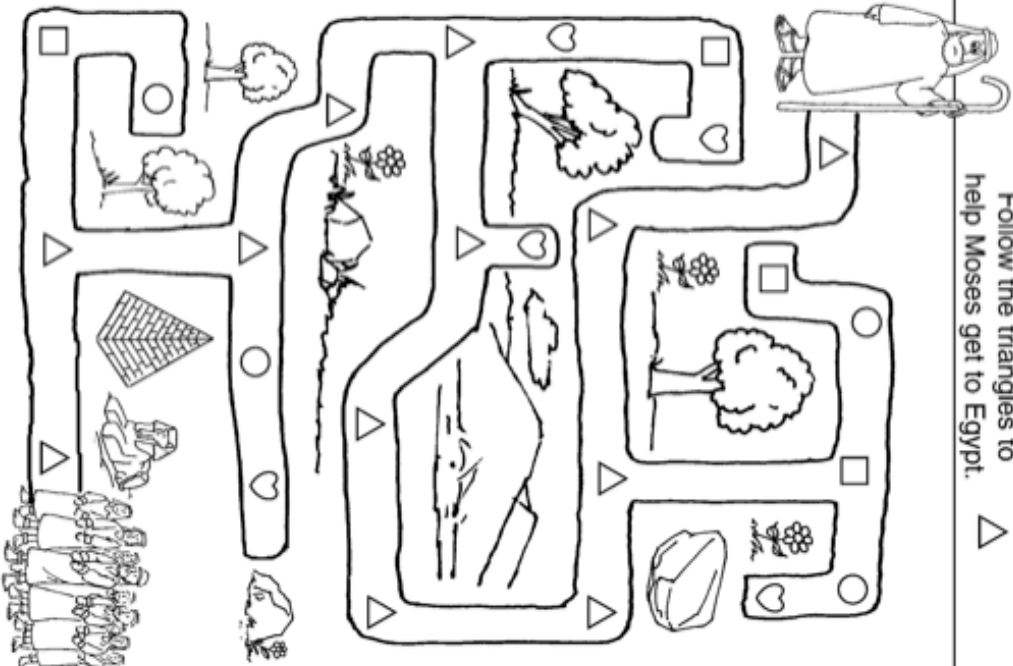
The angel of the Lord appeared to Moses within a burning bush.
