Lesson #5: PLAGUE #10 and THE PASSOVER (Exodus 12:1-36)



The Bible says that God had sent 9 plagues upon Egypt. But Pharaoh's heart was hard. He would not let God's people go. Pharaoh was so angry! He told Moses, "Don't ever come to me again." Moses said, "God will send one more plague. Tonight, the firstborn son of every family and animal will die. Even your son will die, Pharaoh. There will be crying everywhere - except among God's people. After that I shall leave."

God told Moses to tell His people that each family must sacrifice a lamb. The lambs must be one-year-old males. They must be good lambs, not sick or hurt. God's people obeyed.



God told them to put some of the lamb's blood into a bowl. Take some hyssop plant and dip it in the blood. Then put some blood around the door of their houses. That night God's Spirit would go through the land of Egypt. But if He saw blood on the doorposts of a house, He would pass over. No one in that house would die. So, the Hebrews obeyed.



Then the Israelites ate the lamb meat, bitter herbs and bread. They had to prepare all of this quickly. So, there was no time to allow the bread to rise.



They ate flat unleavened bread. Moses explained that this Passover meal was to be eaten every year. And when children asked what it means, they were to explain how God had passed over those homes covered by the blood of the lamb.





At midnight the Lord passed over the land. The firstborn in every Egyptian family was found dead. Even Pharaoh's son died. The firstborn of the animals died too. There was much crying in every Egyptian house. But no crying in the Israelites' houses. God's Spirit had passed over the houses with blood on the doorposts.

Pharaoh called Moses and Aaron to come to him. He said, "Leave! Go and worship the Lord God. Take your families and animals and GO!"



God's people packed quickly. The Egyptian people said, "Hurry and leave." They must have been afraid. The Egyptians gave the Israelites gifts of silver and gold.



God's people left quickly. They had been slaves for 430 years and now they were free!



God had freed His people, just as He had promised!


