Lesson #7: ISRAELITES' JOURNEY: WATER, MANNA & QUAIL (Exodus 15:22-17:7)

The Bible says that the cloud led the Hebrews toward their Promised Land. They traveled in the desert for three days without finding any fresh water to drink.






Then, when they came to some water, it was bitter and undrinkable. They named the place Marah, a Hebrew word for bitter.

The thirsty crowd grumbled, "What are we going to drink?"





Moses cried out to God for help. The Lord showed him a piece of a tree and Moses threw it into the water. Immediately the water became good to drink. Then the people traveled on through the desert to Elim where they found plenty of water to drink. Here they camped by the water and rested. Moses told the people, "If you will listen to God and obey Him, He will take care of you." God keeps His promises!



As the Israelites traveled on, they became very hungry. They grumbled to Moses and Aaron. "In Egypt we had plenty of food. You have brought us out here to starve to death!"


The Lord told Moses, "I am going to rain down bread from heaven for 6 days each week. On the 6th day people should gather twice as much. On the 7th day there will be no bread. It is a special day to rest." Moses told the people, "God has heard your grumbling and is sending bread. Then you will know that **He is the Lord who provides."** You should not complain against God!





The next norming there was dew on the ground. When it dried, it became like thin wafers made with honey. "What is it?" they asked Moses. The Hebrew word for "what is it?" is "manna." "This is the bread from heaven that God promised," Moses explained.

"Gather as much as you need. Don't collect extra and keep it overnight." If they tried to save it, the manna spoiled. But on the 6th day they were to collect extra. It was still good on the 7th day. God didn't want them to work on the 7th day. That was





God gave them meat too. In the evenings quail flew into the camp. The Israelites cooked them and ate the delicious meat. God had promised to take care of His people. He gave them what they needed. They never even got sick. The cloud moved and the Israelites traveled on.

When they camped at Rephidim there was no water to drink. They complained again and got very angry with Moses. "Give us water to drink!" Moses asked, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test God?" Moses cried out to God for help. "What am I to do with these people? They are ready to stone me." God told Moses, "Strike the rock with your staff."



When Moses struck the rock, water burst out, just as God had promised. Everyone had water to drink!




Even though the Israelites kept complaining and grumbling, God kept His promise! God gave them food and water.




