## Lesson #11: JESUS & THE WOMAN AT THE WELL (JOHN 4:1-42)

The Bible says that Jesus and his disciples left Judea to go to Galilee. They traveled through Samaria and stopped at a town with a well. While the disciples went into the city to buy food, Jesus sat down by the well to rest. It was Jacob's well. It had belonged to Jacob hundreds of years earlier.



A Samaritan woman came to the well to get water. Jesus asked her for a drink. The woman was surprised that Jesus would ask her for water. "Why are you talking to me?" she asked. "I am a Samaritan, and you are a Jew." Usually, Jews and Samaritans did not have anything to do with each other.

Jesus said, "I asked you for a drink. You don't know who I am. If you did, you would ask me for a drink. I would give you a drink of *living water*."



The woman was confused. She said, "Sir, the well is deep, and you don't have a bucket. Where do you get this living water?"

Jesus said, “Anyone who drinks from this well will be thirsty again. But whoever drinks of my *living water* will never be thirsty again. The water I give becomes a well inside you and you will have eternal life!”



The woman said, “Sir, give me this water. Then I won’t have to come to this well.”

Jesus said, “Go get her husband.” But, she told Jesus, “I don’t have a husband. Jesus knew she was telling the truth. You don’t have a husband now, but you’d had 5 husbands.”



The woman said, “If you know all about my life, you must be a prophet from God!” So, she asked him, “Do we have to go all the way to Jerusalem to worship God [in the temple?]”



Jesus told her that the way of worship is changing. Soon it will not be like the worship in the Old Testament Law. God wants people to worship Him in spirit and truth.”



The woman said, “I know the Messiah is coming and He will explain everything to us.”


Jesus said, “I am the Messiah.”




