


Lesson 6: JESUS IS TEMPTED (Matthew 4:1-11)



The Bible says that the Holy Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. The devil is also called Satan. The devil wanted to ruin God's plan. He wanted Jesus to sin.

Jesus did not eat for 40 days and 40 nights. He prayed and thought about God's plan for His life. When those days were over, Jesus was really hungry.






Then the devil, who tempts people to sin, came to Jesus. He said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." If Jesus used His power to turn the stones into bread, He could eat them so he wouldn't be hungry anymore.

But Jesus refused. Jesus chose to trust God to meet His needs. Jesus answered by saying God's Word. "It is written, 'Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." **Jesus didn't sin**.

The devil tempted Jesus again. He took him to the top of the temple in Jerusalem. "If you are the Son of God, prove it. Jump off the temple and trust God to protect you." The devil even said, "God's Word says that God will order His angels to keep you safe." The devil had used words from scripture, but Jesus knew that the devil's command was foolish. He didn't jump.



Jesus reminded him, "It is also written: 'Do not test the Lord your God."

Jesus didn't sin.



Finally, the devil took Jesus to a high mountain. He showed Jesus all the kingdoms of the world and how great they were. "I will give you all the kingdoms of the world," he said, "All you have to do is bow down and worship me."

Jesus said to him, "Go away, Satan! For it is written in God's Word: Worship the Lord your God and serve him only." **Jesus didn't sin.** 

The devil left Jesus, and angels came right away to serve Jesus.



The devil has always tried to ruin God's plan to save us.

But Jesus is the perfect Savior – He didn't sin! Satan couldn't stop God's plan!


