


Lesson #8: JESUS' MIRACLES: WATER TO WINE (John 2:1-11)

These pots were usually for holding lots of water for people to wash their feet. Each pot could hold 20 gallons of water.


The servants did what Jesus told them to do. They filled the large pots with water. Then Jesus told the servants to draw out some of the water.









