### Lesson #10: JESUS RAISES LAZARUS FROM THE DEAD (John 11:38-44)



The Bible says that Jesus had some very good friends named Mary, Martha and Lazarus. While Jesus was far away preaching, Lazarus got sick. Mary and Martha were very worried about their brother. They thought Lazarus might die.

“Let’s send someone to go and get our friend Jesus,” the sisters said. “Jesus can help Lazarus get better.” When the messengers found Jesus, they asked him to hurry to Lazarus’ house because he was very sick. But Jesus didn’t go right away. Lazarus died.



After two days Jesus told the disciples, “We must go to Bethany because Lazarus has fallen asleep. I must go wake him up. The disciples did not understand. Jesus explained, “Lazarus is dead.”

Jesus and the disciples arrived in Bethany. Martha went out to meet Jesus and said, “If you had gotten here earlier then Lazarus would not have died!” Jesus said to her, “Don’t worry, Martha, your brother will rise again.” She thought Jesus meant that Lazarus would be alive again when he got to heaven.



When Mary heard that Jesus was in town, she quickly went to meet him. Crying very loudly, she said, “Jesus, if you had been here sooner, Lazarus would not have died.”



“Jesus wept.” That means he cried. Jesus loved his friend Lazarus.



In those times when someone died, long strips of cloths were wrapped around and around the body until the person was all wrapped up. Sometimes sweet-smelling perfumes were put in the cloths. Then they put the body in a cave or a tomb and put a big stone over the door.

When Jesus arrived at the cave, he asked the people to roll the stone out of the entrance. Martha gasped, “Jesus, how can we do that? Lazarus has been dead for four days.” “Martha, just wait and see. If you believe, then you will see the glory of God.”




The people took away the big stone. Jesus prayed. Then he called out in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come forth!”

Lazarus came out of the tomb! He was alive! Jesus told the crowd, “Take his grave clothes off so he can move around.” What a great miracle Jesus did that day!
