Lesson 11: WISE KING SOLOMON

1st Kings 2, 1st Chronicles 23



The Bible says that King David reigned for 40 years. Before he died, he appointed his son Solomon to be the new king over God's people. He told Solomon to always pray to God for help and to obey him. David reminded Solomon that God would keep His promise that every king of Israel would come through their family.

Solomon knew he needed God's help. So, he gave God gifts and worshiped and prayed to Him.



One night, while Solomon was asleep, God talked to Solomon in a dream. God said, "Solomon, tell me what you want to have as a gift, and I will give it to you. You can ask for anything you want."

Wow, anything he wanted!? What do you think you would ask for if you could have any gift you wanted?

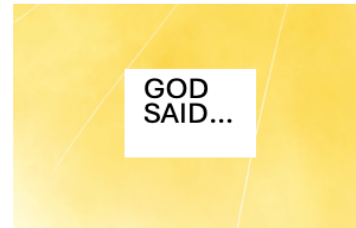

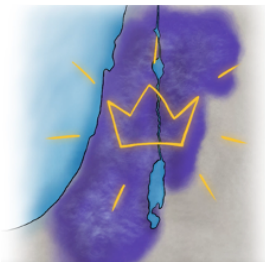
